Learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab has produced a copy of the communication dated 10.05.2023, wherein the Estate Officer (H) GMADA has communicated that the claim of the petitioner is being processed as has been put forth in the legal notice dated 28.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) as served by the petitioner would be decided within a period of six weeks, as the record is old.

In the light of the statement made by the learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, we dispose of the writ petition by directing the Estate Officer (H) GMADA, Mohali to consider and decide the legal notice dated 28.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) within a period of six weeks from today.
