Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the action of the respondents, whereby, the services of the petitioner have been terminated w.e.f. 08.11.2018.

Petitioner is unrepresented.

Pleadings show that the petitioner was working as a conductor on contract basis for 18 days during the strike period and his services were dispensed with on 08.11.2018.

This matter was being adjourned to await the outcome of LPA-228-2020 preferred by similarly placed employees.

State counsel has filed a copy of judgment dated 15.12.2022 passed in LPA-228-2020 and has submitted that the said LPA along with bunch of appeals has been dismissed by this Court.

In view of the above, no relief can be granted to the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed.
