The prayer in this petition is for quashing of the order dated 23.01.2017 (Annexure P-3), vide which the petitioner was declared proclaimed person by the trial Court in FIR No.47 dated 07.04.2016 under Sections 302, 323, 506, 148, 149, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

As per the order dated 10.05.2022, passed by this Court the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaga Magistrate within a period of 10 days from the date of passing of the order and a direction was also issued that he be released on interim bail subject to deposit of cost of Rs.10,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority concerned for causing delay of disposal of the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced the copy of order dated 07.05.2022 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana along-with copy of receipt dated 13.05.2022 showing that the

petitioner had surrendered himself before the trial Court/Illaga Magistrate in compliance of the order dated 10.05.2022 and was admitted to release on bail on furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds to the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with one surety in the like amount.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar, could not dispute the fact that the petitioner is, thereafter, continuously without any default has been appearing before the trial Court/Illaga Magistrate.

Considering the aforesaid fact, the petition is allowed and the order dated 23.01.2017 (Annexure P-3) is quashed.
