The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.98 dated 08.08.2014 under Sections 420/467/468/471 of the IPC registered at Police Station Mehta, Amritsar Rural along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Case has been called, however, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. A perusal of the previous order dated 10.04.2023 reveals that on the said date also there was no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, Amritsar Rural, has submitted that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous in view of the fact that the trial has concluded in the FIR in question and the petitioners stand convicted by the Trial Court vide order dated 01.06.2019. It has also been submitted that an appeal which was preferred to impugn the order of conviction was dismissed by the Lower Appellate Court at Amritsar vide order dated 15.09.2021.
