1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially a writ in the form of certiorari for quashing the order dated 22.12.2022 (Annexure P-1) whereby the appeal of respondent no.5 has been accepted and the matter was remanded to the Director.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the matter has been remanded to the Director, thus, he would limit his prayer to the extent that respondent no.2 be directed to decide the case after remand as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two months from the date of the certified copy of the present order.

3. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent no.5 have submitted that they have no objection to the said course of action.

4. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to decide the case after remand as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two months from the date of the certified copy of the present order.

5. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent no.2 would decide the case independently, in accordance with law.
