Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the charges are yet to be framed, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further but a direction be issued to the trial Court that in case after considering the challan, the Court comes to the opinion that the charges are to be framed against the petitioner, the complainant be directed to be examined as first witness so that the petitioner does not suffer indefinite incarceration during the pendency of the trial.

Keeping in view the fact that the present petition has not been pressed for the grant of regular bail, the trial Court is directed that in case after considering the challan filed, the Court comes to the conclusion that

the charges are to be framed against the petitioner, the complainant be examined as first witness.

The present petition is disposed of in above terms.
