Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to register the land of the petitioners qua sale of its produce under *Meri Fasal Mera Byora* Scheme of Haryana Government for purchase of produce of the farmers.

Learned State counsel submits that he is in receipt of communication No.3871 dated 11.07.2023 where it has been averred that in the event the petitioners herein approach the department through the Deputy Commissioner, Kaithal they can provide the petitioners one time passwords (OTP) to enter the details of their crops alongwith other related details.

Learned State counsel further submits that the Deputy

Commissioner, Kaithal shall duly forward the case of the petitioners for issuances of one time password (OTP) to the petitioners for registration of their produce.

In view of the aforesaid statement made on behalf of State counsel, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.

Needless to mention that the respondent/State shall remain bound by the aforesaid statement.

Learned counsel for the petitioners shall be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition in the event the grievance is not redressed in terms of the statement made in the Court.
