The instant petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.193 dated 18.07.2020, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station City, Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that similarly placed co-accused Muni Lal and Preeti Brinda have been granted concession of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order of even date passed in CRM-M-52087 of 2022 and CRM-M-27759 of 2023.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Since, the similarly placed co-accused of the petitioner have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court, the present petition is also allowed. The petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

It will be open for the Investigating Officer to call the petitioner to join investigation, if so required, by issuing a written notice in this regard and he shall abide by the conditions mentioned in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
