JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. On 23.04.2019, the following order was passed:

“Notice of motion for 02.08.2019, confined only
qua the petitioner having been declared as
deserted, notwithstanding, that he was very
much present in the unit from 04.06.2018 to
09.07.2018 and payment of the unpaid salary to
the petitioner. Qua rest of the relief sought by
the petitioner, the writ petition is dismissed.”
2. The respondent in its reply has confirmed that period in
question has been treated as on duty though disciplinary action would be
taken against petitioner for consistent disobedience of orders of superior
authority.
3. In the wake of notice of motion order dated 23.04.2019 and
reply of the respondent, the present petition has rendered infructuous.
4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
