1. On 18.04.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Through instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 27 dated 27.3.2023, under Sections 498-A and 323 of IPC, registered at Police Station, Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that this Court vide order dated 12.04.2023 in CRM-M-17124-2023 has granted concession of interim anticipatory bail to the parents of the petitioner who are co-accused in the FIR. The parents of the petitioner had joined investigation and the petitioner is ready to join investigation and co-operate in the investigation.

Notice of motion returnable for 12.05.2023.

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To be heard along with CRM-M-17124-2023.

Interim order in the same terms.

The petitioner shall appear before Investigating Officer on 21.04.2023.”

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh, submits that petitioner has joined investigation and no custodial interrogation is required.

3. In view of above facts and circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.04.2023 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

4. If the petitioner or his family members/associates make any attempt to threat/intimidate the witnesses in the present case, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail granted by this order.

5. Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed as expression of opinion of this Court on merits of the case and Trial Court shall proceed without being prejudiced by observations of this Court.
