This is an application for placing on record zimni orders Annexures A passed by the trial Court, in compliance of the order dated 01.02.2023.

Application is allowed. Annexure A is taken on record.

CRM-M-35138 of 2016

Prayer in this petition is to quash complaint No.7553 dated 07.12.2015 (Annexure P.2) filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881; and order dated 02.05.2016 (Annexure P.3) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurgaon, whereby petitioners were summoned to appear in person before the Court.

2. It is revealed that complaint No.7553 dated 07.12.2015 (CIS No.7583/2015) titled "Satpal Vs. M/s Rajbhra Medicare Pvt. Ltd. and others" was filed by the respondent- complainant before learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram, to prosecute the five accused including the petitioners, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. After recording preliminary evidence, summoning order was passed on

02.05.2016.

- 3. Before this Court, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are ready to face proceedings before the trial Court.
- 4. Learned counsel for the respondent has made a request to direct the petitioners not to seek unnecessary adjournments.
- 5. Disposed of with the direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial as matter has already become quite old.
