1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.671 dated 26.12.2021 under Sections 20 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced a copy of application dated 11.04.2023 on which learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak, vide order of even date had directed that petitioner-accused be taken in police custody to the place of cremation of his son today itself immediately and after attending cremation he be taken back in the jail in police custody. Now, the petitioner has filed this petition seeking regular bail as well as interim bail during the pendency of the petition.
3. After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the trial Court for the relief sought in the present petition.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty. In case, such

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application is filed by the petitioner, same shall be considered at the earliest in accordance with law.
