JAGMOHAN BANSAL J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking setting aside of the letter dated 27.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) whereby the respondent No. 4 has terminated the services of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that there is Arbitration Clause in the Contract governing the terms and conditions of the appointment of the petitioner.

3. With the consent of both the parties, Justice Rajiv Sahai Endlaw (Retired) is hereby appointed as Arbitrator to resolve the dispute between the parties. The Arbitrator shall be entitled to fee as per Schedule of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short '**1996 Act**'), which shall be borne by both the parties in equal share.

4. In view of the agreement, the seat of the Arbitration would be at New Delhi. Both the parties, at the first instance, are directed to appear before the Arbitrator on 11.12.2023 (Monday) at the time and place as

communicated by the Arbitrator.

5. A copy of this order be sent to Justice Rajiv Sahai Endlaw(Retired), # 1, Bazar Lal, Bengali Market, Delhi-110001.
6. It is made clear that interim order dated 25.04.2023 passed by this Court shall remain in force till 11.12.2023.
7. The petition stands disposed of in aforesaid terms.
