Present petition has been filed for quashing of the impugned order dated 03.09.2011, whereby, the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala in a case FIR No.92, dated 11.06.2009, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 201, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Ambala, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that this Court vide order dated 11.05.2022 had already stayed the operation of the impugned order and directed the petitioner to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate within one month and subject to his appearance, the trial Court was directed to grant him interim bail. He submits that the petitioner has duly appeared on 16.05.2022 before the trial Court in pursuance to the order dated 11.05.2022 and he has already been released on interim bail. He submits that the co-accused in this case have already been acquitted by the learned trial Court.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has submitted that the petitioner remained absent from the proceedings for about 11 months.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender by virtue of the impugned order, however, in

pursuance to the order dated 11.05.2022, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, it is apparent that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

Let the trial Court proceed with the trial against the petitioner and conclude the same expeditiously as in accordance with law. The petitioner will continue appearing before the trial Court as and when directed by the it during trial of the case.

No further order is required to be passed in the present petition and the same is disposed of in the above terms.
