1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to issue him passport on the application dated 02.05.2022.

2. An FIR No.73 dated 01.05.2014 was registered against the petitioner. The petitioner has been acquitted by the Trial Court. There is another FIR No.159 dated 31.07.2011 which has been registered on the complaint of the father of the petitioner. Petitioner is victim in the said FIR.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already filed reply to notice dated 10.08.2022 issued by respondent. The petitioner has already clarified his position still respondent has not decided application of the petitioner. The case of the petitioner is squarely covered by judgment of this Court in ***Mohan Lal @ Mohna vs.***

Union of India and others 2023 SCC Online P&H 1391.

4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the respondent submits that application of the petitioner shall be disposed of within 6 weeks from today.
