1. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus, certiorari or any other appropriate writ or direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to remove/demolish the gallery and the area of house illegally constructed on the gallery by respondent No.5.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after annexing photographs and also after *prima facie* showing from plans or other documents that the construction raised by respondent No.5 is against law.
3. In view of the above-said statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
