The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.51, dated 13.04.2022, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 341, 427, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been attributed any specific injury, but perusal of the record and with the Assistant of learned State counsel, it is apparent that he was armed with datar alongwith four persons named in the FIR apart from two-three unidentified persons.

It is the case of the petitioner that he has been falsely implicated in the instant case, whereas admittedly was armed with sharped as weapon

namely datar apart from that learned State counsel has produced a copy of the order dated 15.03.2023 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist, Class, Tarn Taran, whereby proceedings under Section 82 of Cr.P.C., have been issued for 29.04.2023. This very fact has been concealed in the present petition, which was filed later to the said order by more than one month i.e., 17.04.2023.

Such concealment of fact cannot be appreciated by any stretch of imagination before the Court of law and it is a settled proposition that a litigant, who does not approach the Court with clean hands and attempts to mislead the Court is not entitled to any relief whatsoever.

Hence the present petition stands dismissed being devoid of merits.

Taking a lenient view i.e., not imposing any cost against the petitioner.
