Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.55 dated 09.08.2020, registered for offences under Sections 458, 323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Thuliwal, District Barnala, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 10.02.2023, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Report has been received from the Trial Court that none of the parties have appeared for recording of their statements. It has been further submitted that petitioner has been declared as a Proclaimed Offender.

Upon instructions received from ASI, Amolak Singh, State counsel submits that FIR under Section 174-A, IPC has also been lodged against the petitioner.

There is no appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Same was the position on the previous occasion. It seems that because of the subsequent development, petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
