The present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.126 dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 148, 149, 308, 323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code, added later on), registered at Police Station Sector-27, District Sonapat, Haryana and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of Compromise Deed dated 07.04.2023 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that all the 07 accused and all the 04 injured persons have entered into compromise, being known to each other. For betterment and for maintaining peace in society, the good sense has prevailed and the parties have entered into a compromise.

Considering the fact that the offence under which the petitioners are facing trial is under Section 307 IPC, though added later on, this Court, at this stage, is not inclined to quash the present FIR. The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court concerned to expedite the conclusion of trial. However, the plea raised before this Court can be raised before the learned trial Court concerned and the latter shall take into consideration before passing the final order.
