DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(Oral)

On 18.04.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.374, dated 02.12.2022, registered at Police Station Barara, District Ambala, under Sections 420, 406, 506 and 120-B of IPC.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in the same FIR, daughter-in-law of the petitioner, namely, Kamaljeet Kaur had earlier applied for anticipatory bail by filing CRM-M-13429 of 2023, in which in order to show her bonafide, she had undertaken to deposit an amount of ₹2,64,000/-, which was under dispute, before the Area Magistrate within a period of one month. Upon such undertaking, this Court vide order dated 24.03.2023 passed in CRM-M-13429-2023, had granted interim anticipatory bail to co-accused Kamaljeet Kaur.

Learned counsel submits that co-accused will abide by that undertaking. Case of the petitioner does not appear to be on any different footing.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. A.G., accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 10.05.2023 for filing status report.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-13429-2023.”

Learned State counsel has submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has since joined the investigation.

In view of the aforesaid and considering the circumstances as mentioned in the order dated 18.04.2023, the said order is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
