1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* directing the respondents to release all the consequential retiral benefits of the petitioner alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the legal notice dated 25.02.2023 has been given to the concerned authorities vide Annexure P-14, but the same has not been considered or decided as yet.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 and Mr. Vikram Preet Arora, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.3 and 4. Both the learned counsel for the respondents have stated that they have no objection in

case the legal notice Annexure P-14 given by the petitioner is considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law.

5. In view of the aforesaid position, this Court deems it fit and proper to dispose of the present petition without calling for reply from the respondents since the prayer is made only for deciding of the legal notice. Therefore, without observing anything on the merits of the case, respondent No.4/competent authority is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 25.02.2023 (Annexure P-14) strictly in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from today.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
