1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-

2. Upon instructions received from ASI, Bhan Singh, State counsel submits that pursuant to interim order dated 29.08.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation. Still further, he submits that the petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
