1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate directions for getting the case FIR No.053 dated 19.03.2010, registered under Sections 420, 467, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh submits that the cancellation report has since been presented in the present case and the same is now fixed for 06.09.2023 before the learned Magistrate, thus the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
