Custody certificate dated 31.05.2023 has been filed today in Court and the same is taken on record.

2. The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0014, dated 19.01.2023 under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, Police Station Division 6, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

3. As per learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant have stated at bar that with the intervention of the respectables, the parties have effected compromise and in pursuance thereof, half of the amount i.e. 3,50,000/- has been paid to the complainant. He has also placed on record the copy of receipt dated 31.05.2023 in this context and the learned counsel for the complainant, as such, submits that the complainant has no objection in case regular bail is granted to the

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petitioner- Jasvir Kaur in case FIR No.0014, dated 19.01.2023.

4.           After considering the rival contentions and the fact that the petitioner, who is a lady, is in custody for last four months and five days in case under Section 420 IPC, triable by the Court of Magistrate and also the fact that the learned counsel for the complainant has no objection to the grant of bail.
5.           In the interest of justice, the petitioner- Jasvir Kaur is ordered to be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar, however, subject to her undertaking that she will regularly appear in the trial Court on each and every date; shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court and shall not tamper with the evidence of the prosecution.
6.           Disposed of accordingly.
