Present petition has been filed under Section 482 CrPC for quashing of FIR No.133 dated 16.06.2015 under Section 380 of the IPC registered at Police Station Chherretta, District Amritsar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

None had appeared in this case on the last date of hearing. The position remains the same even today, despite the case called out twice.

Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 20.03.2023 by way of affidavit of Kanwalpreet Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, West, Amritsar City and makes a reference to para 7 thereof, which reads thus:-

“7. That it is submitted that in view of the above submissions, it is evident that both the parties have entered into compromise and on the basis thereof the aforesaid FIR No. 133, dated 16.06.2015, under Section 380 IPC, Police Station Chheharta, Amritsar has been quashed vide order dated 25.03.2019 passed in CRM-M-2099-2019 by this Hon'ble Court. As such, the present petition having been rendered infructuous is liable to be dismissed.”

In view of the aforesaid, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
