AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. On 21.04.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Present petition has been filed under Section 438 CrPC seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.134 dated 22.09.2021 under Sections 302, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Bahaw Wala, District Fazilka, Punjab.

Learned counsel contends that initially the petitioner initially was named in the FIR, but during investigation, he was found innocent and put in column No.2 in the final report presented under Section 173 CrPC. However, on an application moved by the prosecution under Section 319 CrPC, he has been summoned to face trial.

Notice of motion.

Mr. IPS Sabharwal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and seeks time to obtain instructions.

In case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on or before 27.04.2023, he be released on bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Adjourned to 24.05.2023.

2. Learned counsel submits that in pursuance of aforesaid order, the petitioner surrendered before the trial Court and have been granted bail, which is affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar.

3. In view of the above, order dated 21.04.2023 is hereby made

absolute, subject to compliance of conditions as specified under Section 438(2)
Cr.P.C.
