This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.87 dated 13.05.2013 for offences under Sections 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1) and its subsequent proceedings including charge-sheet dated 23.04.2014 (Annexure P-2) as no offence is made out against the petitioner under the NDPS Act and as per Notification dated 14.11.1985 and the same is abuse of process of Court.

Learned State counsel has produced judgment dated 14.08.2017, passed by the Court of Judge, Special Court, Fatehgarh Sahib whereby, the petitioner has been acquitted. He further submits that in view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
