1. The petitioners are seeking to quash FIR No.06 dated 10.07.2016 under Sections 307, 406, 498-A, 420, 379, 506 and 120-B, IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Women, District SAS Nagar, Punjab and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.
2. Short reply filed by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-1, SAS Nagar on behalf of respondent-State is taken on record.
3. As per the report received from the Court of Judicial Magistrate, the complainant had not got recorded her statement in support of the compromise and has resiled from the amicable settlement.
4. Consequently, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy as may be available, in accordance with law.
