VIVEK PURI, J.(ORAL)

1. On 20.04.2023, the following order was passed:-
 - “1. Petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect her life and liberty as she is apprehending danger at the instance of private respondents.
 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent Nos.4 and 5 had mortgaged their property with Bank of India. The petitioner had purchased the property in an auction. Respondent Nos.4 and 5 are threatening the petitioner in case, she carries out any construction activity. A representation dated 09.02.2023 (Annexure P-5) has already been submitted to respondent No.2.
 3. Learned State counsel seeks time to verify with regard to any threat perception, if any and submit reply in the matter.
 4. On his request, adjourned to 03.05.2023.”
2. Status report by way of affidavit of Bikramjit Singh Brar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has been placed on record.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the only allegation found is to the effect that the private respondents had asked the petitioner to stop the construction but no such incident of giving threats or abusing the petitioner with a threat to kill had happened. Furthermore, as per the version of private respondents, they have already instituted a case before Debts Recovery Tribunal which is pending adjudication.
4. In the event, the private respondents are causing any interference in the matter of construction being contemplated to be raised by the petitioner over a property over which she has a lawful right, the remedy available is civil in nature. No indulgence is called for in the present petition.
