On 21.04.2023, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.39 dated 14.03.2023 registered under Section 379-B IPC, (Sections 379 and 411 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

As per allegations, Police received secret information that Jatinder Singh alias Lada and petitioner Jagmandeep Singh alias Jagman are habitual of committing theft and snatching. FIR was registered. Later on, Jatinder Singh arrested and stolen motor-cycle and three mobiles were recovered from him. Owner of the stolen motor-cycle was associated during investigation, who affirmed the theft.

It is contended by learned counsel that no complaint whatsoever was lodged regarding any snatching incident; that no recovery is to be effected and that the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

Notice of motion.

Mr. P.S. Pandher, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Adjourned to 12.07.2023.

In the meantime, in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without

prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today, it is informed by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaijeet Singh that petitioner has since joined the investigation and that he is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the aforesaid statement, the order dated 21.04.2023 as aforesaid, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
