As the main petition is listed for today, the present application seeking preponement of the case, has become infructuous.

CWP No. 10816 of 2021

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners were working on contract basis and their services have been terminated. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though nobody has been appointed on the said post after terminating the services of the petitioners but the work of the said post exists, hence, the respondents are under obligation to continue the services of the petitioners. Learned counsel

for the petitioners submits that the petitioners be given liberty to file appropriate representation with the respondents so as to agitate that as the work of the post on which the petitioners were appointed on contract basis still exist, they be allowed to continue with direction to the respondents to decide the said representation in a time bound manner so that petitioners do not suffer any prejudice.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in case, any representation is filed by the petitioners, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and in case, any merit is found in the case of the petitioners, the consequential benefits will also be extended to the petitioners within a period of further four weeks.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
