The petitioners are seeking direction to the official respondents to demolish illegal structure from where respondent No. 5 is operating the illegal liquor vend besides other prayers.

Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh has handed over a copy of the notice dated 05.04.2023 issued by the Joint Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh and the same is taken on record as Annexure R-1. The said notice has already been issued to the owner of the shop where the liquor vend is being run. It is stated in the said notice that the owner has to file reply till 21.04.2023. He has further submitted that the competent authority to pass order on the notice is Municipal Corporation which has not been made party in the petition.

Keeping in view the above facts, this petition is disposed of with a direction that Municipal Corporation will take decision on the notice in accordance with law within three weeks. Copy of this order will be sent to Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh by learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh.
