ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 r/w 483 Cr.P.C. seeking entrustment of investigation of FIR No.69 dated 7.4.2021 registered at Police Station Khanna City-2, District Khanna, under Sections 21 (later on added Sections 61, 85) of NDPS Act, 1985, to an independent agency like CBI, the petitioners, claiming to be an aggrieved persons, have come up before this court.

2. After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the main petition with a direction that in case, petitioners file a fresh representation, the concerned SP/Commissioner of Police, shall decide the same in a time bound manner.

3. Given the petitioner's stand, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner files a fresh representation within one month from today, the concerned SP/Commissioner of Police either personally or delegate the same to any IPS Officer under him, shall decide the same within two months from the date of filing of representation. It is clarified that such an order must be a reasoned order, and the same be communicated to the representationists without delay.

4. Liberty reserved to the petitioner to file fresh petition or to take other legal remedies in accordance with the law, in case the petitioners are not satisfied with the
