VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-Board to allow the petitioners' School to submit the online registration/continuation forms along with the fee of 53 students (27 in 12th standard and 26 in 10th standard) and provide special chance to the students of Class 10th to give examination.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has fairly submitted that the last date of admission as mentioned in letter dated 09.01.2023 (Annexure P-1) has elapsed and even last date granted for the purpose of online registration/continuation of students has also elapsed. It is further submitted

that even in a situation, where there is delay in admission and registration of the said students, the Chairman, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali can allow the petitioners' school to submit online registration/continuation forms and has submitted that the petitioners would be satisfied in case, the Chairman, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali considers the representation dated 21.02.2023 (Annexure P-4), in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that any decision taken by the Chairman, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali would be acceptable to the petitioners and the same would not be further agitated.

4. Keeping in view the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with directions to the Chairman, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali to consider the representation dated 21.02.2023 (Annexure P-4) as expeditiously as possible and in accordance with law.

5. The petitioners would be bound by the statement made before this Court to the effect that the decision of the Chairman, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali would be accepted by them and no further challenge on the same would be made.
