The petitioners have filed the present petition with a prayer to direct respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of their lives and liberty and the properties as they apprehend imminent threat at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

The petitioner alleged in the petition that they were owners in possession of the land comprising in Khewat No.86/78, Khatouni No.119, Khasra No.416 (4-2),418 (5-8) measuring 9 bighas 10 biswas as per the jamabandi for the year 2018-19. The respondents No.7 to 11, in connivance with respondents No.4 to 6, who are the police officials wanted to disposes the petitioners from the abovementioned property forcibly and without following with the due process of law. On 27.05.2021, with an intention to grab the said property of the petitioners, the respondents No.7 to 11 with the help of respondents No.4 to 6 attacked them. The petitioners suffered serious injuries

and were also medically examined in Civil Hospital, Bhawanigarh. The matter was reported but no action was taken in this regard. The petitioners also submitted a representation dated 28.05.2021, Annexure P4 but no action was taken as well.

In response to the averments made in the present petition, a status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub- Division Bhawanigarh , District Sangrur was filed on behalf of the official respondents. It has been stated that the representation Annexure P4 submitted by the petitioners was marked to DSP, Detective, Sangrur for enquiry and during the course of enquiry the statements of Surjit Singh son of Ishar Singh, the petitioner No.1 as well the statement of petitioner No.2 were recorded by the enquiry officer. With the intervention of respectable persons of both the sides, the matter has been settled between the parties and the petitioners do not want any action on their applications. The enquiry report was submitted to the SSP, Sangrur on 09.08.2021.

Learned counsel for the State further submits that a land dispute is pending between the parties and preventive action had been taken against the parties vide DDR No.27 dated 06.07.2021 in this regard.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel no further action is required and the petition is accordingly disposed off.
