1. Instant petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.4 to scrutinize the documents of the petitioner.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner had applied for the Group-D post under the ESP category pursuant to advertisement (Annexure P-1) issued by the Haryana Staff Selection Commission. Counsel submits that as per the result declared by the Commission, his roll number figured in the waiting list. All the candidates were called to submit their documents for the purpose of scrutiny. He submits that as the petitioner is employed in the private school in Madhya Pradesh, he could not appear for the scrutiny of documents. Counsel submits that petitioner possesses the Sports Gradation Certificate prior to the cut-off and he has submitted representations (Annexures P-5 and P-6) to the Commission for grant of one

opportunity for verification of the documents, but to no avail. Counsel submits that petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the representations.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr.Pankaj Middha, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
5. Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call for a response from the respondents.
6. Having heard counsel for the parties, but without commenting upon the claim of the petitioner as raised in the writ petition or in the representations, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to examine the representation dated 08.07.2023 (Annexure P-5) within a period of four months from the date of communication of copy of this order. In case, respondent No.4 finds that claim of the petitioner cannot be sustained, an order be passed assigning reasons for rejection within the aforesaid period.
