ANIL KSHETARPAL, J (Oral)

In this revision petition, the petitioner prays for a limited relief. He submits that he immediately requires the amount for running a small business. On account of injury in the railway accident, the petitioner was awarded compensation of Rs.4,00,000/- alongwith simple interest at the rate of 9% per annum. However, 90% of the amount was directed to be deposited in Fixed Deposit Receipt vide order dated 08.12.2021. He submits that during this period of 2 years, the petitioner has been unable to do any work as he does not have resources to run a small shop and due to amputation of his left leg he has been prevented from doing any hard physical work.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is allowed. The Tribunal is directed to release the amount, which was kept deposited in the Fixed Deposit Receipt, to the petitioner.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
