Present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022 seeking grant of parole to the petitioner for a period of 6 weeks in view of application (Annexure P-1) which is already moved by the petitioner with the jail authority concerned in this regard.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that request of the petitioner (Annexure P-1) seeking grant of parole was made in August, 2022 but Superintendent, District Jail, Neemka, Faridabad, Haryana is sitting on the matter and till date, no decision has been taken by the jail authorities on his application (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a time bound direction is given to the official respondents to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion.

Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submitted that in case any application/representation(s) has been filed, the concerned authorities will consider and decide the same as per law.

Counsel for the petitioner is agreed to the aforesaid proposal.

In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
