1. Prayer in the petition under Section 3 of the Haryana Good conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022 is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents/State to grant regular parole to the petitioner for a period of 10 weeks in view of application Annexure P-1 submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.4 on account of the petitioner having been acquitted in case FIR No.359 dated 10.07.2019 registered under Section 42A of the Prisons Act at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad vide order Annexure P-2 passed by the learned Court of JMIC, Faridabad dated 17.03.2023 (Annexure P-2).

2. At the outset, learned Additional Advocate General states that application submitted by the petitioner for release on parole has been accepted vide order dated 01.06.2023 passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Faridabad (letter No.172-6/AP/2023/694-96 dated 01.06.2023). Copy of the aforementioned order has been produced by the learned Additional Advocate General. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof supplied to counsel for the petitioner who states

that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to take appropriate steps in order to secure the release of the petitioner on parole in terms of the aforementioned order.

3. In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any further orders.
