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Mr. Sharad Kumar Yadav, Advocate has put in
appearance on behalf of the appellant and filed his power of attorney,
which is taken on record.

As agreed, as per statements of the Jaibir Yadav-Appellant
appearing in person along with the learned counsel as well as counsel
for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.60,000/-
over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is
awarded to the appellant-Jaibir S/o Shri Ram Avtar Yadav, in full &
final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to
the Insurance Company to deposit a cheque in the sum of
Rs.60,000/- favouring the appellant-Jaibir S/o Shri Ram Avtar Yadav,
with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of
six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9%
per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of
this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from
the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the
cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the
appellant/appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of.
