1. This petition was filed seeking quashing of complaint No. 50 dated 22.3.2014 filed under Section 276 C(2) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 for the assessment year 2012-13 and order of charges dated 24.5.2018 framed in the said complaint.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from his client submits that the petitioner has deposited the amounts determined by Income Tax Department and the offence has been compounded.
3. In view of the statement made, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all pleas before the appropriate Court. There is no doubt that in that eventuality, the same would be considered in accordance with law by the Court concerned.
