The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the respondent Nos.1 to 4 to take appropriate action against the respondents No.5 and 6 and to decide the representations dated 10.03.2023 and 13.03.2023 (Annexure P-1 to Annexure P-3).

Learned State counsel who was served with an advanced copy of the paper book, puts in appearance and on instructions from ASI Karnail Singh, states that petitioner and the other side were called by the police authorities to appear on 15.02.2023. Thereafter, now on expiry of more than a month, on 13.03.2023, a representation has been alleged to be made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur-respondent No.1.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur-respondent No.1 to

look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representations 10.03.2023 and 13.03.2023 (Annexure P-1 to Annexure P-3 respectively) and to decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the certified copy of this order.

A copy of the order, passed after considering the representations of the petitioner, be supplied to him.

Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
