AVNEESH JHINGAN , J.(Oral)

1. This is a petition seeking directions to respondent No. 3 to decide the representation dated 2.6.2020 of the petitioner. The allegations made in the representation were that the father-in-law of the petitioner was murdered.

2. Learned counsel for the State relies upon the pleadings of the status report dated 12.3.2021. He submits that after enquiry, it was found that father-in-law of the petitioner had died due to illness and there was a property dispute between petitioner and private respondents. There was an incident at the funeral ceremony of father-in-law of the petitioner for which FIR No. 127 dated 7.5.2020 under Sections 307/506 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at P.S. Salem Tabri, Ludhiana was lodged.

3. In view of the reply filed, no further directions are called for.

4. Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

5. Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance, if any.
6. Since the main case has been dismissed as infructuous, the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
