1. The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking setting aside of order dated 12.07.2018 whereby Additional Sessions Judge, Nuh has dismissed application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. of the petitioner, seeking summoning of private respondents as additional accused.

2. Reply by way of affidavit dated 02.08.2019 of Dharmvir DSP, Tauru, District Nuh filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place.

3. As per reply, respondents No.2 to 8 have been found innocent during investigation and there is no evidence to implicate respondents No.2 to 8.

4. Learned State counsel submits that there is no infirmity in the order passed by ASJ, Nuh as nothing wrong on the part of respondents during investigation was found.

5. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on

04.07.2022 and today there is no change in the situation. It appears that petitioner has lost interest.

6. In view of categoric stand of the State as well as non appearance of petitioner, there seems no reason to interfere.

7. The present petition deserves to be dismissed and accordingly dismissed.

8. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application, if something survives.
