CRM-29401-2023 in CRM-M-19782-2023

The application for placing on record a copy of the order dated 16.06.2023 as Annexure P-2, is allowed as prayed. The same is taken on record.

CRM-29397-2023 in CRM-M-19782-2023

and CRM-29978-2023 in CRM-M-21977-2023

The applications (CRM-29397-2023 and CRM-29978-2023) are for advancement of the next date of hearing i.e. 23.08.2023 fixed in the main cases i.e. CRM-M-19782-2023 and CRM-M-21977-2023 respectively.

For the reasons mentioned in the aforesaid applications, the same are allowed and the next date of hearing fixed in the aforementioned main cases is advanced to today itself and the matters are taken up for hearing.

CRM-M-19782-2023 and CRM-M-21977-2023

This order shall dispose of two criminal miscellaneous petitions i.e. CRM-M-19782-2023 and CRM-M-21977-2023 as they arise out of the same FIR.

For the sake of convenience, the facts are being taken from the petition bearing No. CRM-M-19782-2023.

2. The prayer in the present petitions under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of regular bail to the petitioners-Sajandeep Singh and Paramjit Singh alias Kala Singh in case FIR No26 dated 27.02.2023 under Sections 307, 160, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

3. The present FIR came to be registered by the investigating agency on the basis of secret information made available to them to the effect that two parties had attacked each other with an intention to kill and members of both the parties had received injuries.

4. The learned counsels for the petitioner-Sajandeep Singh (in CRM-M-19782-2023) and Paramjit Singh alias Kala Singh (petitioner in CRM-M-21977-2023) contend that a compromise has been arrived at with the opposite party of which Harpreet Singh (petitioner in CRM-M-25355-2023) is one of the accused, and therefore, as the petitioners-Sajandeep Singh and Paramjit Singh alias Kala Singh were in custody since 15.03.2023 and 01.03.2023 respectively, they were entitled to the concession of bail.

5. The learned counsel for the State does not dispute the factual aspect as contended by the learned counsels for the petitioners Sajandeep Singh and Paramjit Singh alias Kala Singh.

6. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

7. Admittedly, the FIR came to be registered on the basis of secret information received by the investigating agency, as per which two sides had quarreled with each other leading to the injuries being suffered by both the parties. Now a compromise has been arrived at, and therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners incarcerated.

8. Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petitions are allowed and the petitioners, namely, Sajandeep Singh (in CRM-M-19782-2023) and Paramjit Singh alias Kala Singh (in CRM-M-21977-2023), are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
