1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 31.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) and to revise the pension/retiral benefits of the petitioners by revising/re-fixing the pension of the petitioners by implementing Pension Revision Formula @ 2.59 or of the Central Government @ 2.57% by enhancing the salary of the petitioner according to 6th Pay Commission. He submitted that representation dated 31.05.2022 has been given to the concerned authorities vide (Annexure P-4), but the same has not been considered or decided as yet.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners confines the prayer of the present petition to decide the representation dated 31.05.2022 (Annexure P-4).

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Parminder Kaur, Advocate appearing on behalf of Mr. Sumit Jain,

Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6 and has stated that she has no objection in case the representation (Annexure P-4) made by the petitioner is considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law.

5. In view of the aforesaid position, this Court deems it fit and proper to dispose of the present petition without calling for reply from the respondents or any other authority since the prayer is made only for deciding of the representation. Therefore, without observing anything on the merits of the case, the competent authority amongst the respondents is directed to consider and decide reprsentation dated 31.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) strictly in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from today.

6. The present petition stands disposed of.
