1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.26 dated 08.03.2023 under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and later on added Sections 25/29 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur (Punjab).
2. In para 14 of the petition it has been averred that as per instructions of the petitioner neither any case is pending under NDPS Act against the petitioner nor he is proclaimed offender. However, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, submits that petitioner remained involved in following two cases wherein he has been convicted: -

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He further submits that there is concealment on the part of the petitioner by not mentioning these two cases in the petition.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
