JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 13.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) and communication dated 17.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) whereby petitioner has been transferred from BBMB Talwara to BBMB, Chandigarh.

2. After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that grievance of the petitioner would be redressed, if Chairman, BBMB is directed to look into entire case of the petitioner and hear him before taking any decision.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents does not oppose aforesaid prayer of the petitioner and assures the Court that Chairman being duty bound would hear the petitioner who is none else than employee of the Organization.

4. In the wake of statements of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to Chairman to look into the representation of the petitioner, if any filed by the petitioner, without being influenced by written statement and other affidavits filed before this Court. He is requested to apply his mind independently, grant opportunity of personal hearing and redress grievance of the petitioner within 2 weeks from today.
