1. This is the 1st petition filed by the petitioner under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in:-

2. Mr. J.P. Jangu, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed Vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

3. Upon instructions from ASI Gulab Singh, State counsel submits that petitioner has joined and co-operated with the investigation. Still further, he submits that he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
