1. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 4 to take action on the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P -4) and to get the Government Quarter No.51, Area Labour Colony, Industrial Area,-A, Ludhiana vacated from the possession of respondent No.5 and her relatives.

2. Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 to 4/Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana has submitted that since the Quarter No.51 was in possession of respondent No.5, thus, instead of Quarter No.51, Quarter No.2 has been allotted to the petitioner, vide letter dated

21.03.2022 (Annexure R-4) and the said order/letter has not been challenged.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to challenge the said letter/order dated 21.03.2022 (Annexure R-4) in case the petitioner is dissatisfied with the same.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
